Club Policy Regarding Dogs at the Bull Mountain Ski Facilities

To Have Fun, Safe Skiing with Your Dog.

NOTE: “Owner” refers to the person in charge of the dog while at the Bull Mountain facilities.

- **Responsibility:** Owners are fully responsible for their dogs. Where an incident with a dog takes place, the Owner is responsible.
- A maximum of two dogs per skier under full control of their owners.
- Dogs are permitted :
 - On the Kiwanis/Spur/Cataline/Little Britches trails which are a series of easy loops – follow the “ORANGE DOG” signs.
 - See the Bull Mountain trail map.
- Dogs are NOT permitted around the Warming Hut, Timing Hut or staging areas.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash until the dog trail is reached. (This is for the safety of other skiers who may not be aware that there is a dog on the trail.)
- Individuals using club facilities where dogs are permitted should be prepared to meet dogs at any time in those areas mentioned above.
- Skiers with dogs are expected to remove dog waste from any area and dispose of it in an appropriate manner.
- **Access to Dog Trails:** Turn right after coming through the gates in the parking lot fence and follow the short, uphill access (approx. 100m) until it levels.
 - Dog trail loops begin at the junction of “Kiwanis” (first trail on your right) and the designated dog trail along the right (north) side of the stadium to “Spur” and “Cataline”.
